

Thank you for registering for the playground build day on 4/18! Your help and participation is appreciated. If at any time you become aware you will not be able to participate as scheduled, please go to the playground website registration as soon as possible to re-enter your information with a note that you will need to cancel.

Below are some answers to Frequently Asked Questions.

Questions & Answers:

Q: What time is the build day on 4/18?

A: The main body of volunteers should arrive at 8am for check-in (name tags, release forms, etc) and project assignments. We do need a limited number of volunteers to arrive at 7am to help unload the playground equipment (please use the comments section on the registration or contact link on this page if you can come at 7am). The actual building of the playground will take place from 9am to 3pm, with clean up from 3pm – 5pm.

Q: Will food, water, and restrooms be provided?

A: Yes. Coffee/Doughnuts will be provided in the morning, and lunch will be provided around noon. Water will be available at all times. A Porta-a-Potty will be provided for use as needed.

Q: Is the build day rain or shine on 4/18?

A: Yes. In the event weather is so inclement that the build day cannot be held on 4/18, you will receive an e-mail that morning notifying you the build day is re-scheduled for 4/19.

Q: Do I need to bring tools?

A: No you do not need to bring tools to participate. Everyone should bring a pair of gloves and wear sunblock. There will be tools (from the Atlanta Community Tool Bank) provided on site for volunteers. If you can bring your own utility knife and/or tape measure that would be helpful. If you have tools you would like to offer for build day, please use the comments section on the registration or contact link on this page.

Q: Will there be activities/supervision for kids?

A: Yes. Activities & care will be provided for children too young to participate in the actual build day, so that both parents can participate in the build. Please use the comments section on the registration or contact link on this page letting us know how many children (if any) you plan to bring that would not participate in the actual build day & would need activities/supervision. The minimum recommended age to participate in the build day is 13. Parents will need to sign release forms for children under 18 to participate in the build day.

Q: What does the equipment look like, and where is additional playground information?

A: Visit <http://phnaplayground.org/> for updates and playground information. Drawings of the actual playground equipment will be posted soon.

Q: Will there be parking available?

A: Yes, with limited space. There will be on-street parking on the streets around the playground (Linwood and Williams Mill). If it is possible for you to walk to the build day, that would be great and is preferred.
